We are now operating under the new **Instruction Set lesson management system.** For those of you who are new to this system, each New Masters course is divided into Lesson Sets: groups of assignments that students are to do each lesson in the order they are listed. The instruction for each assignment is provided individually on laptops. which frees me up to monitor each student's performance and adjust their mechanics. The assignments (and thus the lessons) are divided into 3 parts: worksheets, in which students learn the physical movements, postures and methods of drawing; draw-along-video drills that establish those skills as a habit and drawing projects in which the newly learned skills and methods are applied, integrated and displayed.
